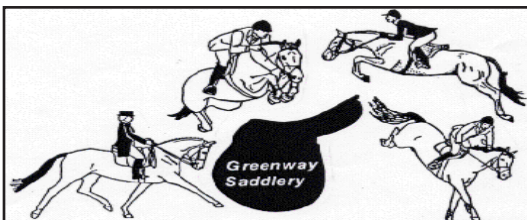

Rules, Regulations and Information

Crossroads Farm and the horse show management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Questions not addressed in these Rules and Regulations will be decided by Crossroads Farm and the horse show management. All decisions will be final.

Crossroads Farm and the horse show management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes without claims to damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes or make any changes management deems in the best interest of the show.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of Crossroads Farm and the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the show, its members, management and employees and facilities harmless for any loss or accident to the horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

A. Arrival/Departure: Horses may arrive Saturday, Dec. 5 at any time after 6:00am and must leave by an hour after the conclusion of the horse show, the same day.

B. Haul-In Fee/Parking: Haul-ins for the show are \$10 per trailer. Parking is available for trailers and cars in the parking lot of the Sun Valley Community Church, 456 E. Ray Rd., Gilbert, AZ 85296.

C. Entries: Entries may be filled out at the show with no penalty. To encourage pre-entries so the show office rush is reduced, please have complete entries mailed, attach a check paid in full to Crossroads Farm and mail it in, postmarked by Dec. 5. If you pre-enter, but do not show for any reason, you will receive a refund minus the \$25 Office Fee.

D. Attire/Equipment: Proper basic show attire (boots/jodhpur boots and britches, collared shirts) and equipment for the horse is encouraged. Footwear with at least ½" heel and an approved hard hat are mandatory. Boots and wraps are permitted on horses in hunter classes. Martingales are prohibited in all under saddle classes.

E. Arenas: This show will utilize one arena for showing (located on the east side of the barn with the judge's stand), two arenas for loungeing and one arena for warm-ups. Please follow the posted signs and directions upon your arrival for designated rings and only perform the tasks allowed (i.e. only loungeing in the designated rings, etc.)

F. Returned Checks: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled according to the following procedure: A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EVERY RETURNED CHECK (MINIMUM OF \$25!) Accounts will be given ten (10) days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the Maricopa County Attorney's Office for prosecution.

G. Schooling: The competition ring will be available for schooling between 6:30am-7:30am Saturday, Dec. 12 at no charge for competing horses or for \$25 per non-competing horse. Horses MUST be checked in and wearing their assigned numbers to participate in schooling. No exceptions will be allowed.

H. Horse Identification: All horses competing or non-competing must display an assigned number while being ridden on the grounds after 8:00am Saturday, Dec 12. Numbers will be assigned for non-competing horses by the horse show secretary. Horses not displaying a number will not be allowed in the warm-up area or competition rings, no exceptions.
